- #300 Laurent Perrier Brut NV, France** €95
A beautiful blend of chardonnay & pinot noir- Laurent Perrier is a 100% family owned house since 1812 & well known for its elegant, fruity style.
- #304 De Castellance Brut Rose, France** €75
Light colour with red berry bouquet, elegant aromas of red fruit made from 40% Pinot Black, 30% Pinot Meunier and 30 % Chardonnay.
- #305 Laurent Perrier Vintage 2010, France** €220
A glorious wine, using only the best grapes of the vintage – harmonious & biscuity with great persistence and structure.
- #306 Moet & Chandon Brut Imperial, France Snipe (200 m)** €26
Radiant aromas, revealing bright white fruit flavours, floral lime blossom and elegant blond notes of brioche and nuts.

Sparkling Wine

- #302 Maschio del Cavalieri, Prosecco D.O.C Frizzante, N.V,** €35
This Frizzante offers fantastic rich peach flavours that finishes on an extremely elegant citrus note.

Rose Wine

- #232 Rose, the River Garden, South Africa 2016** €27
Delicious fresh red berry aromas and summer fruit flavours, a touch of spice enhances this delicious, summery wine.

Red Wine by the Glass

- Cabernet Sauvignon, Los Tilos, Central Valley Chile 2015** €6.75
Fruity with pleasant aromas of cherry and plum, well balanced with notes of white pepper and paprika.
- Merlot, Los Tilos, Central Valley, Chile 2015** €6.75
Fruity with blend of toast tobacco and chocolate, medium bodied.
- Shiraz, William Hardy, Australia 2015** €7.75
Full bodied wine with aroma of black pepper, spice and cherry fruits.

White Wine by the Glass

- Pinot Grigio Veneto La Castelia Italy 2016** €6.75
Dry and soft with delicate straw yellow colour.
- Sauvignon Blanc, Los Tilos, Central Valley, Chile 2015** €6.75
Fresh, intensely fruity with lemon, grapefruit and nectarines aroma, and a dry, fruity finish.
- Chardonnay-Albarino, Raimat, Spain 2015** €7.75
Rich aroma of tropical fruits and citrus with appealing minerality.

Red House Wines

- #105 Merlot, "Alba" Santa Luz, Chile 2016** €26
Berry and plum aromas and flavours, supported by the soft, well-rounded tannins of this classic grape variety.
- #104 Malbec, Paula by Dona Paula, Argentina 2016** €33
Rich and spicy with fresh red and black fruit flavours and aromas, smooth and round with an elegant finish.
- #126 Shiraz, GB 56 Grant Burge, Australia 2014** €31
Full bodied wine with blackberry fruits, complemented with rich pepper and vanilla spice, well balanced, great with roast meats or steak.

White House Wines

- #209 Chardonnay, GB 32 Grand Burge, Australia 2014** €36
Fresh, full bodied with lemon zest, white peach flavours and white flowers and a touch of honey. The palate is ripe and creamy with a clean citrus finish.
- #230 Pinot Grigio, Trulli, Toscana IGT, Italy 2015** €31
Dry and soft with lovely fruity aromas and flavours. Crisp and fresh.
- #222 Pasquiers Sauvignon-Vermentino, France 2016** €28
Fruity and aromatic wine with crisp fruits on the nose. It's light bodied and crisp with a clean and refreshing finish.

Red Wine Selection

- #109 Rioja, "Ederra", Bodegas Bilbainas, Spain 2015** €32
Intense cherry-red colour. Impressive with its outstanding aromatics of red fruits, mineral smoke and subtle oak notes.
- #111 Salentino, "Liante", Castello Monaci, Puglia, Italy 2016** €35
Black fruit aroma, soft with integrated tannins and lifted acidity, medium bodied with tobacco and smoky vanilla flavours.
- #112 Rasteau, Les Bastilles, France 2014** €46
Plenty of ripe fruit aroma like currant, blackcurrant, raspberry. Deliciously soft, well balanced palate.
- #113 Pinot Noir, Stoneburn, New Zealand 2015** €37
Rich and fresh with a wonderful bouquet of raspberry and red fruits. Smooth and silky with a balanced finish.
- #123 Cotes du Rhone, Vieilles Vignes 2015** €34
Produced from 40-year-old vines, this wine is round and soft with lots of bright red fruit, a hint of earthiness and pepper spice. Ripe & warm on the palate – delicious.
- #124 Joseph Drouhin, Fleurie, France 2015** €48
Maison Joseph Drouhin produce a stunning example of this style, surprising colour and body, it's rich and full with lovely berry aromas and flavours. Persistent and elegant on the finish.
- #107 Crozes Hermitage, Cave de Tain, France, 2013** €44
Classic Crozes nose with perfumed fresh berry underscored by rich notes of pepper and roasted meats. Very well balanced, long acidic finish.
- #128 Burgundy, Cotes de Beaunes, Joseph Drouhin 2013** €55
A biodynamic producer, Drouhin produce wines of wonderful purity and finesse. This Pinot has a ripeness that is often lacking in the Cotes de Beaunes and has a silky length and savoury structure.

Half Bottle Selection Red Wines

- #20 Beaujolais-Villages, Joseph Drouhin, France 2013** €20
Fresh and fruity with raspberry colour and brilliant hue. The nose is both refined and intense with notes of violet, peony and red fruit syrup.
- #190 Fleurie, Maison Joseph Drouhin, France 2013** €25
This single estate Fleurie made from the Gamay grape has raspberry fruit flavours with a medium body and good finish.

White Wine Selection

- #240 Gavi, La Soraia, Italy 2016** €38
Light and fresh on the palate with further zesty notes, along with fresh grapes and honey. Elegant and crisp with a refreshing, dry finish.
- #259 Chardonnay "Laforet", Bourgogne, France 2014** €36
Bring Chardonnay back if this is what it means - an excellent dry un-oaked wine with a good long finish, a versatile pairing for most foods.
- #224 Chablis, Moillard, France 2014** €46
Fresh, sharp and mineral, perfect with raw or cooked fishes but also, with white meats in sauce.
- #238 « Les Gourmets » Touraine, Sauvignon Blanc, 2014** €36
Very well – balanced, soft, characterful wine with good acidity and lots of citrus fruit aromas. A popular style.
- #220 Riesling, Trimbach, Alsace, France 2015** €36
A benchmark style – always dry and crisply elegant- Trimbach are renowned for producing some of the world's greatest Rieslings. Try this wine, you won't be disappointed.
- #227 Hunter's Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ 2016** €36
Ernie Hunter, a Belfast man, founded this estate in the 1970s, now led by his wife, the award-winning winemaker, Jane Hunter. Citrus fruits on the nose with some herbaceous, gooseberry notes. Very crisp and elegant, a great example of what New Zealand can do with this grape.
- #264 Pinot Gris Reserve, Trimbach, Alsace, France 2014** €48
Intense apricot and almond characters with a hint of spice. This is an underrated grape variety, that goes so well with food. Rich and smooth with a long lingering finish.
- #229 Sancerre Comte Lafond, de Ladoucette, France 2016** €48
Intensely aromatic, with citrus and stone fruit aromas with a mineral backbone. Very elegant and lean, with wonderful intensity of fruit. A classic from the house of the Baron de Ladoucette in the Loire Valley.

Half Bottle Selection White Wines

- #294 Chardonnay Macon-Villages J.Drouhin, France 2014** €20
Very straight forward and direct on the palate- fruity and easy drinking with an elegant finish.
- #291 Pinot Grigio, Lamberti, Italy 2015** €18
Light lemon colour, delicate, nutty with mineral aromas. Crisp and light palate with a medium finish
